No thoroughfare



No smoking



No naked flames

Not drinking water



No heavy load



No metallic articles or watches



Do not extinguish with water



Do not climb



Do not touch



Switch off mobile phones



No dogs allowed



No reaching in



No pushing



No sitting



No stepping on surface



In the event of fire do not use this lift



No eating, drinking



No access for persons with pacemakers



Do not obstruct

PROHIBITORY SIGNS



Do not wear gloves



Do not walk or stand here



No photography



Do not use lift for people



Do not tie knots in the rope



Do not use this device in a bathtub, shower or waterfilled reservoir



Do not use scaffolding incomplete



Hot works prohibited



Do not alter the state of the switch



No leaning



No children allowed



No unauthorised access



No access for people with metallic implants



No access for forklift trucks and other industrial vehicles



Do not wear metal-studded footwear



MANDATORY SIGNS



Wear eye protection



Wear head protection



Wear ear protection



Wear respiratory protection



Wear foot protection



Disconnect before carrying out maintenance or repair



Wear protective clothing



Wear a face shield



Wear a safety harness



Wear protective gloves

Disconnect mains plug from electrical outlet



General mandatory sign (to be accompanied where necessary by another sign)



Connect an earth terminal to the ground



Pedestrians must use this route
